In Canada, 92% of adults over the age of 65 live in the community (Stats Can, 2014)

- - Presently more adults over 65 than young people under 15 years (Stats Can, 2016)

○ In NB, 49% of the population resides in rural communities

- - With age, especially with the presence of dementia, there can be a loss of ability to use and understand a second language.
